QUESTIONS GRIEVING CHRISTIANS ASK: WHY DID GOD LET MY LOVED ONE DIE?

KEY POINTS:

- God sometimes answers our prayers with miracles and sometimes he doesn't. And, most often, we don't know why he answers as he does.
- We can become discouraged or elated by God's answers to prayer.
- In such times, we must remind ourselves about God's character, his promises and his love for us. He may seem to us as though he is absent when our prayers are not answered.
- God understands our pain because he has felt that pain and more. He didn't spare Jesus from death.
- While not knowing why God didn't save your loved one is disorienting and unsatisfying, the pain you are feeling is more about the emotional pain of loss than your unanswered question.
- God may not tell you 'why' he didn't answer your prayers the way you wished. But, he will sit in the pit of despair with you for as long as you need.
